Motion by F. Bannister and seconded by Flor to approve the treasurer's report which included a current balance of \$199,533.33. Motion carried. D. Knutson reported that the November '07 mailing generated about \$8000.

F. Bannister announced that a 2nd solicitation letter will be mailed this summer. After careful analysis it was determined that giving is most generous and consistent from alumni who graduated between 1942—1960. There are about 690 donors from these classes who will receive the letter.
