The informal meeting was called to order by President Waterhouse with the main purpose of discussing All School Reunion plans for September 16, 2006.

Printed minutes of the last CASF meeting and All School Reunion Planning Meeting #3 were distributed by Olson.

Dewey reported that the City of Chetek has reserved Airport Park, on September 16, 2006 for the reunion.

Olson shared catering information from Adventures Restaurant in Rice Lake. Adventures can serve 500 people, buffet style, and provide china, stainless flatware, and plastic glassware for about \$12 (+ tax and tip) per person.

The following tentative schedule of events for the All School Reunion was proposed:

- 10:00 am --12:00 am: Open House, coffee and rolls and tours of High School
- 11:00 am --1:00 pm Booster Club lunch available on school grounds
- 1:00 pm Football game
- 6:00 pm Social Hour at Airport Park
- 7:30 pm Catered Dinner at Airport Park

Additional ideas included:

- Arranging for golf carts to be available to transport guests to the football field during Open House.
- Securing two banners (one to be hung across 2nd Street and one to be hung on or in high school) *Chetek Area Scholarship Foundation Welcomes Alumni*. These could be reused for subsequent CASF events.
- Arranging for live music to entertain during the Dinner.
- Requesting that the CHS Band perform a 50's theme tribute at halftime in honor of the Class of 1956 who are celebrating their 50th year.

Dewey will arrange for tour guides for the school tours.

Dewey will approach Dolly Neby and John Dutmer about providing music during the dinner.

Dewey will approach Bruce Kamrath about the band performing at half time of the football game.

Waterhouse will approach the Chetek Booster Club about sponsoring a tailgate party prior to the football game.

Waterhouse will investigate banners.

Waterhouse will investigate procuring beverages for the social hour and dinner through *Boston's*.

Waterhouse will contact Fred Bannister to arrange for the rental of tents, tables and chairs for the dinner.

Olson will contact *Adventures* and set up a "tasting" for the catered meal for Monday, March 13, 6:00 pm at *Adventures Restaurant*.

Olson will contact *The Chetek Alert* about including an article about the reunion in an upcoming issue.

Olson will check with Mel Eckerman about re-linking the existing CASF link with *The Chetek Alert* to the new CASF webpage which is part of the school website.

In other business, Dewey reported that the CASF Scholarship due date is April 12, 2006 and CHS Awards Day has been set for May 24, 2006.

Waterhouse appointed F. Bannister, Mary Huset and himself to be the Scholarship Selection Committee.

The next meeting was set for Monday, March 13, 2006, 6:00 pm, at Adventures in Rice Lake for a "tasting" to decide upon Reunion Dinner menu. The April meeting was set for Monday, April 17, 2006, at 7:00 pm at the Super 8 in Chetek.
